Your Bus Service



Metro does not run buses or trains. Metro aims to ensure travel needs are met by paying for additional services which are not commercially viable, such as rural, early morning, late evening and Sunday services.

Timetables may vary during holiday periods and it is advisable to check with MetroLine or the bus company prior to travelling.

What's new in this timetable

This summer service has been reintroduced to operate Easter Sunday and Monday 12/13 April and then every Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday from the early May holiday.

The timetable and route has not been changed.

The 24 hour clock

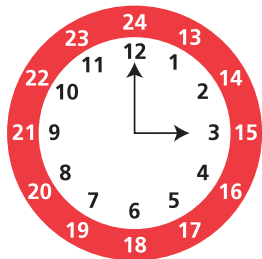
This is used throughout this guide to avoid confusion between morning (am) and afternoon (pm) times.

How to use the bus


- At the stop or shelter please indicate clearly to the bus driver that you intend to get on the bus.
- When you get on the bus please tell the driver where you are going.
- If you can give the exact fare, please do so.
- When you are getting close to the stop where you want to get off please ring the bell once, then stay in your seat until the bus stops.
- Smoking is not allowed on any buses.
- For the safety and security of passengers all bus stations, some bus stops and some buses are fitted with CCTV equipment.

Using our bus stations safely

When using Metro's bus stations:

- Directional signs and notices are there for your safety, please follow them.
- Please follow instructions given by the station staff in the event of an evacuation of the bus station.
- Do not walk in the bus area at any time.
- Ask one of our customer advisors or security staff if you are unsure where to go.
- Follow any safety announcements or directions given out over the bus station public address system.
- Do not leave luggage unattended. Keep your own belongings with you at all times.

Pay before you travel

MetroCards, West Yorkshire DayRover and all other passes and permits carrying the Metro  symbol can be used on most bus services in West Yorkshire.

Other tickets and cards issued by operators are only valid on that operator's service.

Rural Bus Service 906

Summer service 906 serves Widdop Reservoir and Hardcastle Crag. Service 906 operates Easter Sunday and Monday 12 and 13 April then Saturdays and Sundays between 2 May and 4 October 2009 and on Bank Holiday Mondays: 4 May, 25 May, 31 August 2009.

Hebden Bridge Rail Station, Hebden Bridge Hope Street, Hollins Place, Keighley Road, Midgehole Road, **Hardcastle Crag**, Midgehole Road, Keighley Road, Hollins Place, Commercial Street, **Hebden Bridge Rail Station**, Hebden Bridge New Road, Market Street, Bridge Lanes, Bankfoot, Mytholm Turning circle, Bankfoot, Heptonstall Road, Heptonstall, Hepton Drive, Longfield, Southfield, Hepton Drive, Towngate, Smithwell Lane, Slack, Widdop Road, Black Dean, to **Widdop Reservoir** Car Park.

From Widdop Reservoir Car Park via reverse of above route to Hebden Bridge Rail Station (in Heptonstall all buses run via Hepton Drive, Longfield, Southfield and Hepton Drive).

Hail and Ride

Service 906 operates on a hail and ride basis between Heptonstall Road to Widdop Reservoir. The driver will stop on request where it is safe to do so – just signal clearly to the driver in good time.
