Overall Assessment: General condition of footpaths, stiles and signage is excellent. There is evidence of regular footpath use, so most paths are clear of excessive vegetation. The temporary diversion to R.O.W. at Broadbottom Farm (due to building work on barn) seems to have been removed. The big dog (always seems to be tied up) is still there to bark at you when you pass.

Comparison With Information In Previous Report: n/a

Maintenance Problems Or Difficulties To Formally Report To Calderdale MBC: The footpath running SW from Burlees Lane (starting just west of Burlees Farm) is overgrown in one section by brambles - the only way to pass safely was to leave R.O.W.

Other Particular Problems Or Difficulties Encountered: Large fallen tree seems to block R.O.W. route through Broadbottom Wood. The route is not entirely clear in the wood and the tree is easy to walk around.

Other Comments, If Any: At the top of Red Acre Wood (at the gate and heading south), markers clearly indicate that the path going east (along the top edge of the wood) is a R.O.W. - this seems to contradict the information on a recent OS map, which does not show a path of any kind.
