Overall Assessment: In general, the paths in the area are good. However, towpath from lock 14 to bridge at Pickwicks Boat Shed still have dog fouling in areas. The bin has been removed a number of months ago and seems no chance of getting another. Also, at lock 14, someone has put up a plastic bin liner which is now in general use. Fastened to the concrete railings just past the lock.

The path on the opposite side of the canal running parallel with the canal is generally ok. At the moment it is dry and clear, but is not really accessible for every one as it is undulating in some areas. The path leading off from this which is through the second gate leading up to Heights Gate has high rough grass along its whole length but is still fine to walk. If carrying on along the main path, at the far end which meets the road coming down from Heights gate (near Callis) the old access gate has been replaced by a plastic covered wire fence which is quite narrow, making it difficult to pass.
