Overall Assessment: Generally good. Paths covered from Stoodley Lane up London Road, through gate onto top path running parallel with Stoodley Pike, around back of the pike and back down onto original path again, then continue onto Heights Gate and down path back onto canal side at Callis. Overall walking is fine on all these paths at the moment as land has been reasonably dry. Turning down from the path below Stoodley Pike past a derelict farm building is unclear. Think this is because it is not walked very much. There is a stile but people tend to walk across the wire fencing which is down in parts. The path runs between two fields. Looking to the left before reaching the stream going up to Heights Gate, the farmer is building a new road up to this derelict building. The area around the stream is messy and once over, the ground is wet, in part because the farmer sometimes grazes cattle on it. Views are beautiful however, well worth seeing
