Overall Assessment: This report comments on the repairs done as a result of the original report.

Re the missing stile on Boston Hill: A well-made stile has been built over the wire fence and is easily seen from a distance due to the upright post with yellow paint on it.

Re the overgrown path and broken wall at the top of Boston Hill: The footpath has been cleared, the wall rebuilt, and there's new signs at either end of the path.

Re the broken kissing gate: The post on the kissing gate is now upright but the fastening at the top hinge appears to be a temporary repair. The hinge on the gate is resting on the head of a bolt which has been placed through a hole in the post. If the gate is lifted up it comes away from the post. The bolt is loose and could be removed.

Maintenance Problems Or Difficulties To Formally Report To Calderdale MBC: Please could you make a more permanent repair to the kissing gate at 997 284?

Other Particular Problems Or Difficulties Encountered: In Old Town there are many new footpath indicators, eg yellow markings, new signs. It's a great improvement.

Other Comments, If Any: Well done to Calderdale MBC for responding to the initial report and, apart from the minor problem on the gate, doing a very good job with the repairs.
